word.We will meet in Rooms 204-206. Parents are invited to meet next door in Room 208 for casual conversations about life and faith.




Grace Space

Opening Prayer and Spiritual Formation led by Nicole Paul

Keith Boggess led the Leadership Equipping conversation based on Chapter 1 of 5 Practices of Fruitful Congregations

Key points included

- -reflection and adaptability when getting out into the community
- -moving from attractional model
- -not just being welcoming hosts but also good guests when we are out in the community
- -not doing ministry FOR somebody but doing it WITH somebody

Goal accountability updated provided by Pastor Stacy and Robert Moore

- -Current Accountant, working on end of year close to line items
- -Cynthia (potential new accountant) will be available to meet and help after April 15th
- -auditor change discussed as well
- -Work on getting Key individuals (common users) together for Churchtrac meeting
- -Average 170-180 in person attendance, this led to the question to ponder about how are we connecting with new guests
- -Children's Build your own worship bags are up and running

Consent Calendar passed

Formally re-elected Robert Moore as Chair of Trustees for 2024

Strategic Planning led by Robert Moore

- -Discussed supporting innovative ways to fundraise for ministry activities such as grants, business sponsorship, etc
- -Plan to develop a formal budget process and meeting time with ministry leads to promote pre-planning of budget going forward
- -Board voted to approve financial support for Youth and Young Adult ministries including ASP, Youth Choir and Mission Blitz.
- -Board voted to approve financial support for Drama Ministry which will be presenting "Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat"

The Board will start thinking about the Gifts/talents that will be beneficial for new class of 2025 member to present to Nominations and Leadership Development Team to start their work

The Leadership Board will hold a Work Session April 8th to continue strategic planning and generative work.
