# **Strange But True Stories** from 31 Years of Adopt A Highway Cleanups

Grove Church volunteers picked up 61 bags of trash this year along the three mile stretch of Whitford Road and Grove Road near the church. That's a lot of trash that did not end up in the sewer system or in the bubbling creeks that run along the roadside – piles of bottles, plastic and metal that no longer spoil the view for drivers and neighbors.

But every now and then Grove's Adopt A Highway participants find some mighty unusual things that make them laugh and shake their heads in wonder. This includes a fifteen-year-old's learner's permit, an unopened wrapped ham, a golf hat from the U.S. Open, numerous balls (soccer, baseball, tennis, golf), and handfuls of coins that end up in Grove's offering plate. But the most unusual was probably the live baby bird that Rae Guthrie and Krista Carstens found this Spring. It was lying next to the road and there was no sign of a nest or parents so the baby was taken to a wildlife sanctuary.

Customers will be provided with boxes and able to peruse the selections and pick what they like. They will then pay by the ½ pound for their filled boxes.


