If you want help figuring out a theme, we've had several over the years.....baking, cooking, Italian, reading, movies, music, baby, household fix-it items, bar-b-que, college, chocolate, beauty, exercise, crafts, pampering, scrapbook, coffee, tools, family fun, games, emergency, cleaning, gardening, sports, teacher, cleaning, and socks! Whatever you come up with, we're happy to have it.



We may have empty baskets for you so please feel free to check with me first before you purchase a container if you do not have one.

Tips: Please no alcohol. **Do not cellophane baskets.**

And of course, come out to Auction Night and see the baskets and bid on them! Have fun with this while helping to support Youth Missions as they go outside of Grove walls to perform mission work.
