


smile you will get when presenting them with a box of these Oreos.

Grove's Good Works volunteers started off the new year with a productive January workday. With a team of 10 volunteers, we were able to work on a lot of projects at Mikkie's home. Here's a brief look at what we did.



Linda and Jack tackled the rickety basement stairs which were a major safety concern. They shored up the stringers, stabilized and leveled the steps, and installed all new treads. It made a tremendous difference, and we all benefited. Mikkie was delighted.

We're building a bathroom in the basement where only rough framework and plumbing have existed for many years. Our plan was to tear out a wall and parts of the floor that have deteriorated and begin rebuilding with a slightly expanded footprint. Joanna and Richard formed our demolition team, and as expected, the more they uncovered, the more issues they discovered. We're off to a good start, but this is a project we'll be working on for quite a few months.

Penny, Cindy and Mikkie worked together to prepare the kitchen floor to receive vinyl plank flooring. To get it ready, they tore out the old vinyl, sealed unused vents, shored up and patched portions of the subfloor, and leveled the surface. With that done, everything's ready for the new floor to go in next month.





There's nothing like trying to install a pre-hung door when the walls aren't straight and nothing's level. That's what Brad and Steve discovered as they were putting in a door at the top of the basement steps. With a shove here and a shim there, they got the job done.

Several people, including Dan, began replacing tiles in the drop ceiling. That's the kind of job he was able to start and stop easily to lend a hand when needed to help with installing that door and shoring up the kitchen floor.

With so much going on, there are a few volunteers who serve critical support roles. Steve George is our Technical Leader and he provides guidance as needed on every project. Betty, as our Work Crew Leader, supports all our volunteers to see that they have tasks to work on and everything they need to complete them. Denny and Scott keep us happy and energized by providing fabulous lunches each workday.

There are several ways a 'basket' can be put together. A group can put everything together from start to finish, supplying the container and all items, or you can provide the items and we'll take care of putting the finishing touches on the final presentation and finding a container. 




