



### Donate much-needed men's underwear to Philadelphia prison inmates for Easter

Each inmate arriving into the Philadelphia Prison System is given ONE pair of underpants and no undershirts or socks. Can you imagine living with only one pair of underpants?

Last year, the Undies for Easter campaign was able to deliver over 2000 men's briefs and over 2000 men's undershirts to the Head Chaplain for the Philadelphia prison system. The Chaplain, Carmelo Urena is now again in need of assistance for the over 4000 incarcerated individuals in his care as he aims to provide at least one additional pair of briefs, an undershirt, and socks to each individual entering incarceration.

We have set up a new Undies for Easter Gift Registry on Amazon.com.\*\* Use this link https://bit.ly/3ESTHLK to Purchase items, and choose the delivery address for EPAUMC Prison Ministry.

We hope to collect and deliver at least 2,000 pairs of briefs, undershirts, and socks through this campaign to support the chaplain's efforts. This campaign will end on Palm Sunday, April 13; and all purchased underwear will be delivered to the chaplain before Easter Sunday.





### **Decluttering Giveaway**

The Community Engagement team has decided to have a Decluttering Giveaway at Grove, which is an opportunity to get that clutter out of your house and find a place where it is needed. This is a new event, and more details will be coming. Here is a description of what is planned so that you can start to collect items to give away. The Decluttering Giveaway will be in the Grove parking lot on Saturday June 7<sup>th</sup>.



The plan - the "givers" will come to Grove with their items in their trunk and set up in a parking space. The use of card tables or other ways to display items is encouraged, but the space is limited to the area around the car in one parking space. "Takers" will be invited to come and shop that day. This event will be held rain or shine. Each car is responsible for taking all items away at the end of the event.

For large items such as furniture, pictures can be posted on a poster with contact information, so that "takers" can arrange for pickup.

This event will be open to Grove congregation, neighbors in our community, and Grove Preschool families. It will be advertised in ways similar to advertising a garage sale, but will be called a giveaway, with signs along the road, postings on social media, and in Grove newsletters and emails.

Because everything is free, we will take the opportunity to collect donations for a yet-to -be-determined cause..

"Givers" will be required to register in advance. Givers will bring a car filled with the items available to give away and will commit to take back all items left over. We need to have at least 20 cars signed up to make the event a success.

We all have items in our homes that we don't really need or use. It feels so good to put those items to good use and to free up space in our homes! We think this will be a fun event for our congregation and for our community.

### You can never have too much JOY!



If you haven't done something lately, you're missing out on more JOY. Each of us has gifts we can share. What are you waiting for?



We may have empty baskets for you so please feel free to check with me first before you purchase a container if you do not have one.


Tips: Please no alcohol. Do not cellophane baskets.


