and box-up packages of nutritious freeze-dried ingredients to provide meals for the Hungry. Invite your friends, neighbors, and family members – all are welcome to help! There are jobs for everyone of all ages and stages (standing and seated) at the event and even "runner/running" jobs for the younger kids! For those under 6 years of age, childcare services will also be available.



Donate much-needed men's underwear to Philadelphia prison inmates for Easter

Each inmate arriving into the Philadelphia Prison System is given ONE pair of underpants and no undershirts or socks. Can you imagine living with only one pair of underpants?

Last year, the Undies for Easter campaign was able to deliver over 2000 men's briefs and over 2000 men's undershirts to the Head Chaplain for the Philadelphia prison system. The Chaplain, Carmelo Urena is now again in need of assistance for the over 4000 incarcerated individuals in his care as he aims to provide at least one additional pair of briefs, an undershirt, and socks to each individual entering incarceration.

We have set up a new Undies for Easter Gift Registry on Amazon.com.**

We hope to collect and deliver at least 2,000 pairs of briefs, undershirts, and socks through this campaign to support the chaplain's efforts. This campaign will end on Palm Sunday, April 13; and all purchased underwear will be delivered to the chaplain before Easter Sunday.





- Support the *Undies for Easter* challenge sponsored by the Prison Ministry during April. Or if eye-opening, thought-provoking books are your passion, find out what the Prison Ministry book group is currently reading.
- Sign up for the Rise Against Hunger event on April 6 to help package 22,000 meals and help fight hunger around the world. This is a great event for all ages.
- Declutter your home and give away the things you don't need at Grove's free Flea Market event in June. Register now to participate. Or volunteer to help during the event.
- Repair homes for deserving low-income homeowners with the Good Works Ministry. Spring is one of the best times to try one of our monthly workdays.
- Come to a Community Dinner. Enjoy good food and fellowship with members of the church and the community. Or volunteer to set up or help prepare and serve the meal.
- Volunteer with the Grove team at CYWA. This food distribution program operates
 2 days each week to provide nutritious food to community residents.
- Help in the Community Garden growing food for the West Chester Food Cupboard.
 During the spring and summer volunteers help plant, water, and harvest the produce.

- Sign up for an Adopt-a-Highway cleanup event. Help keep the roadways around Grove free of litter and other debris.
- Prepare and serve meals at the Salvation Army of West Chester. Volunteers join Grove teams to serve meals on assigned days. Or sign up to be a substitute.
- Serve coffee to parents on the first day of preschool. A smile and a kind word can
 ease stress and show the welcoming and caring nature of our Grove Church family.
- Participate in the CROP Hunger Walk. Sign up sponsors to support you as you
 walk to help end hunger one step at a time.
- Trunk or Treat is a thrill for kids of all ages. Decorate your trunk and hand out candy to the costumed kiddies. Or volunteer to help with the event.
- Be a Salvation Army Bell Ringer at Christmas time. This is a great family opportunity.
- Donate gift cards for families needing food or presents for their children at Christmas. A limited number of children of incarcerated parents may be available to purchase gifts for.
- Donate food, books and other products to any of our year-round ministries including the Free Little Pantry and Library, The Laundromat Library League, Circle of Giving, and Paper for People.


