
John, and more. Jesus's message is not only life-changing, but world-changing.

We welcome visitors - do let us know if you are in the DC area. Our new address is 3148 Gracefield Rd, Apt 404, Silver Spring, MD 20904.



Here are this month's book recommendations for families with children.




Breathe is a journey through Ascension, Pentecost, and Ordinary Time.

"The day of Pentecost is coming. The church is changing color. The white and gold of Easter will soon burst into flaming red, then cool to green."

So begins Breathe: A Child's Guide to Ascension, Pentecost, and the Growing Time. Breathe explores children's questions: How can Jesus go away, yet promise to be with us always? Can we trust someone who comes and goes so mysteriously?

Written in both prose and poetry, Gathered at the Table engages children as it begins with the example set by Jesus at the Last Supper in Jerusalem and shows readers that even though there are many ways to take communion, the meaning is the same: in Communion, we remember Jesus. Ever since Jesus shared bread and wine with his disciples, Christians all around the world gather to celebrate Communion so they can remember Jesus too. The bread

reminds us of Jesus's body. The wine reminds us of Jesus's blood. Bestselling author Glenys Nellist takes children ages 4-8 through the action of communion and encourages them to reflect on the mystery of this holy sacrament. Gathered at the table, Sharing wine and bread. "I want you to remember me," Jesus softly said.


